The new email address to use when you wish to contact the office is [hello@cubert.org.uk](mailto:hello@cubert.org.uk)

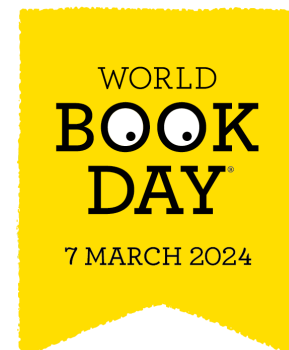
