

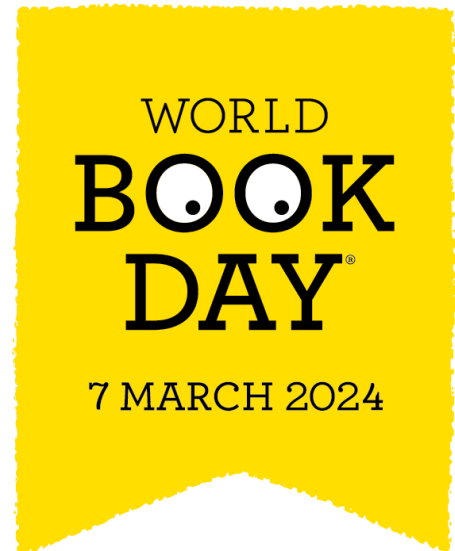


Dear Parent/Carer,

Our recent Sports Hall Athletics Competition was a great success. Our pupils showed off their skills and gave it their all. The competition was tough, but our squad handled it!

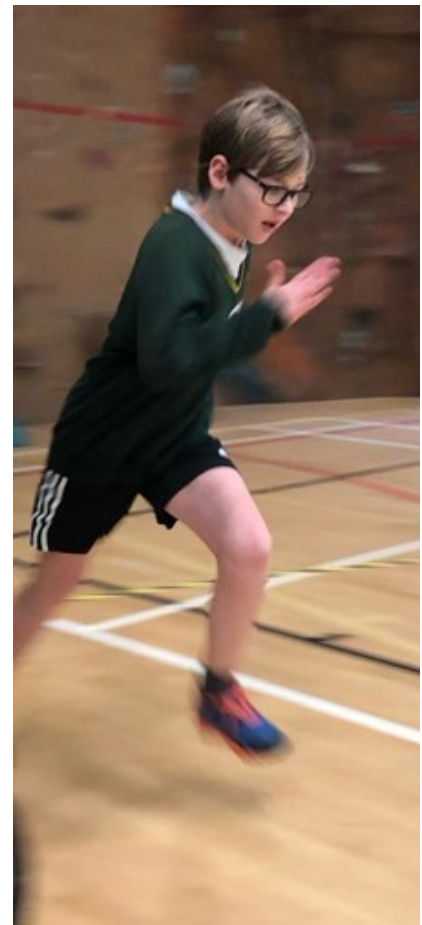
