Near miss this morning

The following information has been reported to us from a very concerned parent.

This morning two Year 6 girls were walking along the pavement coming into the school road.

As they got to the double yellows many cars had parked on there again including a big van. The driver did not see the girls walking along the pavement and reversed straight into the gap (just before the first bungalow opposite the entrance to Lapwings class) to do a 3 point turn so very nearly taking both girls down with it as they weren't even maneuvering slowly.

A reminder that parking on double yellows is illegal. Doing a 3 point turn on a busy school drop rather than waiting and turning at the end of the road is not acceptable. Mounting the pavement when children are walking along it is also unacceptable.
