Communication for pick up

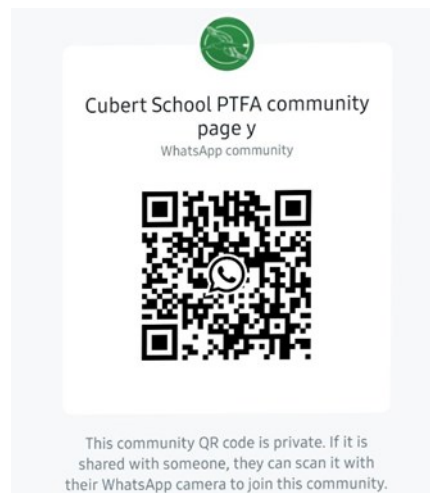
We shall also share the weekly newsletter in picture form, for easy accessibility and quick reference to important information.
