Parents evenings

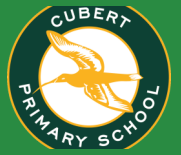

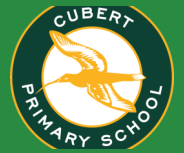


Maritime Museum visit in Falmouth

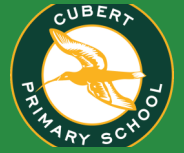
