Cubert Statutory Consultation for conversion

As per our previous communication with stakeholders, we detailed that the governing body had been assessing the best future for Cubert School. We are pleased to state that we are now entering the next phase and have been approved in principle to convert to an academy and join a multi-academy trust.




